Reputation: content vs. manner

- **Content > manners**
- Your reputation is determined by the content you contribute...
- ... and not by the style/manner/presentation of the said content ...
- Your present-day reputation is determined by your present-day contribution.

Reputation: social network vs. content

- **Content > social network**
- Your reputation depends on your **own** contribution, but it does not depend on who you are and who your friends are.
- Your contribution to the project is solely judged by your activity within the project, never by your past, present or future activity elsewhere.
- We are primarily here to advance the project, and building a social network is only a side effect, not the goal of the effort.

Failing to comply

- Decisions are made by the project owners/admins.
- Decisions are subjective - we will not pretend social interaction can be judged objectively.
- The project owners/admins may decide that a member's contribution does not justify their behavior and eject the member from the community.
